Serene HomeShare – WordPress Contact Form Setup Instructions

Purpose: This one-page guide explains how to implement a single contact form with role-based auto-responses on a WordPress website using common form plugins. All inquiries route to one inbox while triggering different confirmation emails based on role selection.

Recommended Plugins

Use one of the following WordPress form plugins (all support conditional email logic): Gravity Forms, WPForms, or Fluent Forms.

Step 1: Create One Contact Form

Create a single contact form. Do not create separate forms for each audience.

Step 2: Add Role Dropdown (Required)

Field Type: Dropdown / Select

Label: I am contacting Serene HomeShare as:

Options: Referral Partner, Property Owner, Self-Pay, Other

Step 3: Configure Auto-Responses

Create four confirmation emails within the form settings. Each email corresponds to one dropdown option. Set the sender to info@serenehomeshare.com.

Step 4: Apply Conditional Logic

Use the plugin's conditional notifications feature so that the selected role triggers the matching auto-response.

Step 5: Internal Notification

Create one internal notification email that sends all submissions to info@serenehomeshare.com, including the sender's name, email, selected role, and message.

Recommended Form Wording

Form Title: Contact Serene HomeShare

Message Prompt: Please briefly describe your reason for contacting us.

Submit Button: Submit Inquiry
